#### **INTENDED USES:**

**RUST VETO 344** is intended for the long term preservation of ferrous or non-ferrous metal parts which are to he stored indoors or outdoors, without wrapping, under the most severe climatic conditions.

# **METHODS OF APPLICATION:**

**RUST VETO 344** can be applied neat by brushing, dipping or spraying at room temperature. The product may be diluted with Stoddards Solvent for ease of spraying. When the product is applied as a dilution it is advisable to apply 2 coats and to allow the first to dry for 12 hours before the second is applied.

When using a petroleum solvent, the coated parts should be immersed in or wetted by the solvent and, when the film has been softened it should be wiped off with rags saturated with the solvent.
